BROADWATER WESTERN DAYS RODEO RULES

Ages for entries; Adult 18 & over. Kids events 2-17. No youth can compete in adult events.

Age is determined at the time of rodeo signups not at the time of the rodeo.

- 1. All entries must be accompanied by fees.
- 2. Absolutely NO LATE ENTRIES
- 3. No trading of positions.
- 4. There must be (3) three entered in an event or the event will not be held.
- 5. Residency requirement: Must reside in Broadwater County from Feb. 4, 2022 to Aug. 4, 2022.

Five places 34-26-20-13-7
Four places 40-30-20-10
Three places 50-30-20
Two places 60-40

- 7. Contest events- NRA/NWRA rule book applies for standard events- High School rule book applies in nonstandard events such as: goat tying and pole bending- National Senior Pro rules apply to Ribbon Roping (Men & Women Only as partners). Points count for each contestant in ALL events except *Parent/Child team roping with partners.
- 8. No exhibition rides.
- 9. Team Roping: Must enter as a team. Both ropers get full points as individuals.

- 10. Old Timers: Only one team member can be over 50. Both ropers get full points as individuals.
- 11. **Parent/Child** team roping: Only child pays fees. Only the child gets points. A child who has **no parent** to rope with can rope with anyone who is a legal resident according to rule #5, or the parent is in the military service stationed elsewhere and the substitute parent is at least 18 years of age or older.
- 12. Must be ready to compete when called upon.
- 13. Children's events will be held on Thursday and adult events will be held on Sunday.
- 14. Absolutely **NO** refunds between sign-up date and rodeo in any event.
- 15. 16 **Point system:** 1st place- 6 points, 2nd place- 5 points, 3rd place- 4 points, 4th place- 3 points, 5th place- 2 points, 6th place-1 point.
- 16. Children being aided by an adult will receive **no** points or money. Adults are required to wear NRA rules attire.
- 17. **ONLY** Broadwater County horses can participate.
- 18. All NRA rules apply in all instances including western attire: western hat, boots, jeans, long sleeved western shirt and belt
- 19-A. Children **are eligible** for entry into the Broadwater Western Days who live with a divorced parent during the summer months.
- 19-B. Students who are enrolled in a college with their home residence listed as Broadwater County **are eligible.**
- 19-C. Enlistees in any branch of the Armed Services and their home address is Broadwater County and this includes their immediate family (wife/husband and/or children) are eligible.
- 19-D. If work draws one away from Broadwater residence for a period of time, the continuous 6 month period rule will be waived so one may still enter the rodeo contingent on the Board of Directors decision. Directors will have the final say.
- 20. Hide Race rules: Co/Ed only
- 21. A (1) one minute time limit will apply in the calf roping.
- 22. In the event of a tie in the All-Around the Board will determine the best way to resolve the tie.
- 23. The Board of Directors has the right to refuse entry to anyone by a majority vote and has final determination in the definition of all rules.
